Tallahassee Looks at HOA Operations

It was reported recently in the media that Florida lawmakers will have an opportunity to pass legislation in 2024 that will "increase transparency and accountability of homeowners across the state". One of the proposed bills would require homeowner associations to provide copies of the association rules and covenants to every member by October 1, 2024, and every new member thereafter. It will also require the homeowner associations to post their rules and covenants on the home page of their web page. 
Another Charity Event Open to All Women Residents

The Laurel Rd. widening progress is moving along but certainly slowly. As reported in Parcels regularly, the County basically makes the final call on the road. The Neal/Stantec design team is working in cooperation with the County which will probably result sometime soon in a public presentation. Stay tuned.

The Appeal Court has still not rendered a decision regarding the appeal of the City's decision approving the Commercial Application. Some experts are estimating it may be in the summer. If the court approves the appeal, the issue returns to City Council for another hearing on the matter. Although the applicant has the right to begin work on the area, there appears to be no visible evidence of that taking place.
