- According to CVS corporate execs, the opening of its Laurel Road store has been postponed until January 2011.
- •Kudos to Board member Jerry Jasper for coordinating an agreement with Ajax Paving Co. outlining stipulations to limit Ajax's present and future operations, as well as a payment of \$50,000 for a tree buffer along a portion of the wall on the north side of the VGRC.
- The new Mykka River Park is a beautiful site for nature lovers. However, the new park comes with some serious issues that affect our residents including the condition of the road leading into the park and the safety and security of residents. Your VGRC Community Association is working closely with both county and city officials to address these issues.

The Myakka River Park landscape buffer project is now complete thanks to Gary Hansell and others.

- There has been no finality to the Chinese drywall problems that some of our residents are facing. Although the most recent news from the federal judge in New Orleans was quite positive, the trial itself did not directly impact those in the Venetian. The Sarasota Herald ran a very enlightening front page article on May 30 about this problem and WCI which you may find of interest.
- If you are a Florida resident, we encourage you to register to vote. It is easy (http://www.srqelections.com/) and will allow your voice to be heard. In November, voters will decide three Venice City Council seats.
